



Cadex Medication Reminder, Medical Alert, Databank and Watch.

Introduction

The Cadex® watch reminds the user with a repeated 'beep' and on screen message when they have to take medication or what they have to do at pre-programmed times. The data bank holds valuable information for both the user and the emergency services in the event of an adverse incident.

Who is it for?

- people who need occasional reminders
- who need to take medication at specific times
- who are generally able to administer their medication regime independently of other support
- who still lead an active lifestyle.

Cadex Watch Key Points:

- Up to 12 Daily Alarms with programmable text reminder messages and snooze function.
- Personal medical condition data e.g: Diabetes, Asthma, Epilepsy, Aphasia, Parkinson's.
- Allergic reactions data e.g. Penicillin, Bee sting, Nuts.
- Emergency contact details.
- Medications and due time.
- Blood group, Date of Birth, Doctors details etc.
- Has a watch function so is more likely to be used, rather than left at home or on shelf.
- Can be worn by carers to advise emergency contacts about responsibility for care if the carer is injured.
- Can only act as a prompt.
- Alert button allows emergency services to access the user's details in the event of an adverse event.
- Not suitable for those with hearing impairment.

Cadex Paediatric:

A paediatric version is available with the easy-to-change Velcro strap which adjusts to the growing child's wrist.
